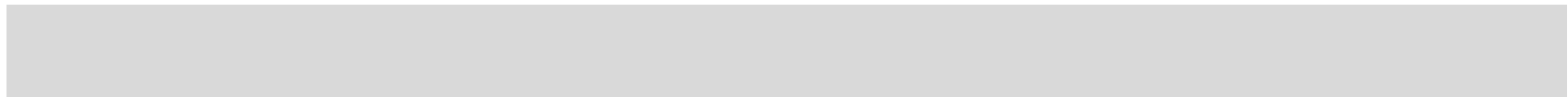


Career and Technical Education Instructional Program Information
