

TITLE 1 PARENT RIGHT TO KNOW

As a parent of a student at a Title 1 School, you have the right to know the qualifications of the classroom teachers who instruct your child. Federal law allows you to ask for certain information about your child's teachers, and requires us to give you this information in a timely manner. Specifically, you have the right to ask the following information:

- Whether the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction.
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other temporary assignment, and the job of the teacher and any other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher, and the field of discipline of the certificate or degree.
- Whether your child is provided services by a paraprofessional and if so, their qualifications
